



2007 – 2008 INTERNSHIP AWARD Call for Applications

The Art Libraries Society of North America is now accepting applications for its annual Internship Award. The ARLIS/NA Internship Award provides financial support for students preparing for a career in art librarianship or visual resources curatorship. This award grants \$2,500.00 to support a period of internship in an art library or visual resources collection.

Who May Apply

Students currently enrolled in, or having completed within the last 12 months, a graduate program in library science, art history, studio art or museum studies may apply for the award. Applicants must have completed at least 10 credits of their graduate coursework before the application deadline, or demonstrate an equivalent combination of coursework and relevant experience.

Flexible Internship

With the approval of the ARLIS/NA Internship Award Sub-Committee the winner selects an institution to act as host for the internship. The intern is required to work on site at their chosen host institution for a minimum of 150 hours. Winner has twelve months from date of their notification to complete the internship.
